**ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

1. The Tea Packing (State) Conciliation Committee published 23 April 1993 (274 I.G. 971), be dissolved.

2. There be established a new Tea Packing (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees engaged in tea packing throughout the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

*excepting* —

Employees engaged as storemen and/or packers in connection with the bulk packing or transport of tea;

Female employees employed in wholesale grocery stores and factories.

3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).

5. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.

6. This order shall take effect on and from 24 October 1995.
