FISH CANNING, &c. (STATE) CONCILIATION COMMITTEE

INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

(No. IRC 2243 of 1995)

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Fish Canning, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee published 23 April 1993 (274 I.G. 973), be dissolved.
2. There be established a new Fish Canning, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All employees in fish preserving and canning factories engaged in cleaning, treating, preserving, canning, labelling and packing fish and all other employees employed in operations in or in connection with the factory incidental to the above in the State;

excepting —

Employees in seagoing trawlers and on coal hulks or lighters;
Electrical fitters, electrical mechanics, fitters, turners, blacksmiths, coppermiths,
oxy welders, and scientific instrument makers;
Watchmen, caretakers, cleaners and gatekeepers;
Employees in freezing or cold storage works or chambers;
Engine Drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in
or about the driving of engines, electrical crane, winch and motor drivers;
Storemen and packers packing for transport;
Box and case makers, sawyers and tailers-out;
Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen and drivers of motor and other power-
propelled vehicles;

and excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the Watchmen and Gatekeepers (Waterfront) Conciliation Committee.

3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales, and one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).
5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
6. This order shall take effect on and from 24 October 1995.
