ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established The Spastic Centre of New South Wales Employees (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees of the Spastic Centre of New South Wales who are engaged in the provision of services to the disabled and who come within the Constitutional Rules of The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales and employees of the Spastic Centre of New South Wales who are employees with a disability.

Excepting those employees who come within the jurisdiction of the Clerks (State) Industrial Committee.

And excepting also those employees who come within the industries and callings which were within the jurisdiction of the Trained Nurses, &c., Other than in Hospitals, &c. (State) Industrial Committee as at 23 March 1993.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Spastic Centre of New South Wales.

Alternate representatives of employers may be nominated by the Spastic Centre of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales.

Alternate representatives of employees may be nominated by The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 8 December 1998.
