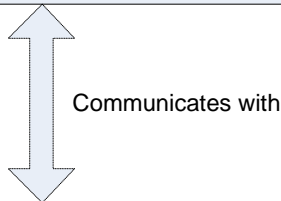

Introduction of new systems for the Land and Environment Court (LEC)

In late May 2016, the current case management systems used by the LEC, *ciTIS* and *eCourt*, will be replaced with *JusticeLink*, *Online Registry* and *Online Court*.




JusticeLink
Internal court system for case management
Used by Registry staff and staff of Judicial Officers
Also accessed by Judges and Commissioners


Online Registry
External website for court services
Used by legal practitioners
Also accessed by self litigants and public

Within the Online Registry Website:



Examples:

- View case information
- File documents online




Online Court
Enables parties to make requests for orders to be made online

All three systems are integrated such that data is communicated between the systems to ensure consistency and accuracy of information from a single source of truth.

For example, *Online Registry* displays a record of all documents filed, *Online Court* shows a log of all requests and orders made, all of which update *JusticeLink* in real-time.

What the changes mean to you

Key Changes related to the current services	
eCourt no longer in use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> From the date of the new systems, eCourt will no longer be authorised for use to file documents online or make online requests for court orders. eCourt will only be available to access historical case information. eCourt records will no longer be updated, and new cases will not be put on eCourt.
New file numbers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File numbers will change, with the Class of jurisdiction no longer appearing in the file number. The new format (used in <i>JusticeLink</i>) is illustrated below: 2015 / 00124728 – 001  Year Case no. Proceeding no. The first proceeding '001' is the substantive proceedings, and each Notice of Motion filed in a case will create a new proceeding number
Current cases	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only current files (as at the date of new systems) will be moved to the new system. Current files (as at the date of the new systems) will be provided with new 2016 <i>JusticeLink</i> case numbers. Use the new case number when using the <i>Online Registry</i> e.g. for case look-up. If a file has not been moved to the new system, and you believe it needs to be (e.g. if it is a closed case in which you wish to file a notice of motion), contact the registry by email to lecourt@agd.nsw.gov.au

Key changes and how to prepare for the Online Registry Website and Online Court	
Key benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Solicitors and barristers can access the Online Registry Website Improved access to case information for each court file. Improved process for requesting sealed copies of orders, for filing documents online and for seeking court orders online.

You must be registered to use the Online Registry Website	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you already have a log-in, you will have immediate access to LEC cases. If you are not registered: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> follow the steps on the website ask for support by calling 1300 679 272 or emailing onlineregistry_support@agd.nsw.gov.au
Online Court Cut-off times	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any requests for an order to be made online must be submitted via the Online Court by 12pm the business day prior to the listing.
Keep up to date with Online Court	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure you are registered as the <i>Solicitor on record</i> or <i>Contact solicitor</i> to receive email notifications whenever an Online Court event occurs.
